**His Honour Judge Gerard Phillips, President of the Workers Compensation Commission**. Judge Phillips was educated at St Patrick's College Strathfield and the University of Sydney. He has Bachelor and Masters' degrees in Law. He was appointed as a judge of the District Court of NSW and President of the Workers Compensation Commission in 2019.

His Honour was a solicitor in private practice for over 30 years before his appointment. In practice he specialised in employment and industrial law, conducting cases in all states of Australia. Judge Phillips was admitted and practiced in the UK for 2 years while undertaking post graduate legal studies. He was a partner at the global law firm K & L Gates and was a member of its Global Management Committee.

**Kim Rosser, Member, NSW Civil & Administrative Tribunal (NCAT)**

Kim Rosser has been a Member of the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal since its inception in 2014 and is currently a Principal Member allocated to the Consumer and Commercial and Appeals Divisions. She was previously a Member of the Consumer, Trader and Tenancy Tribunal for a number of years and has also been a Member and Senior Member of the Social Security Appeals Tribunal and the Refugee Review Tribunal. Kim's career in Tribunals began in the 1990s when she was one of the first Conference Registrars appointed to the Commonwealth Administrative Appeals Tribunal.



**Ashley Cameron, Barrister, Greenway Chambers.** Ashley is a barrister at Greenway Chambers. She has particular interest in Building and Construction Law, Insurance and general commercial.

Ashley was called to the Bar in 2019. In 2018, Ashley received both the Ludlows Award

(awarded to the individual who receives the highest overall mark in the NSW Bar exams) and the Katrina Dawson Award (awarded annually to one woman who has passed the NSW Bar exams and is committed to starting practice at the Bar).

Prior to coming to the Bar, Ashley was the tipstaff to the Hon Justice Robert McDougall in the Supreme Court of New South Wales in 2014. She then worked in the commercial litigation team at TressCox Lawyers (later, HWL Ebsworth Lawyers) for over 4 years and was promoted to Senior Associate in the commercial litigation team within 2.5 years of her admission. As a solicitor, Ashley practiced across a broad range of dispute resolution matters, including Building and Construction, Insurance, Professional Negligence, Contract and commercial disputes.
