In 1997, she was called to the NSW Bar, and enjoyed a broad practice at the Bar, which included a significant amount of pro bono work.

Her contributions to the NSW Bar outside of her practice as a barrister, include service as an Executive member and member of Bar Council, and service as a member of the Equal Opportunity Committee of the Bar Association of New South Wales.

On 1 May 2009, her Honour was appointed as a Judge of the Land and Environment Court of New South Wales.
